DIGITAL ASSET CUSTODIAL SERVICES TERMS

Last Updated: 21 June 2023

These Lightbit Digital Asset Custodial Services Terms ("Custodial Terms") shall apply to the custody of Digital Assets by Lightbit on your behalf entered into between Lightbit and you.

All terms and references used in these Custodial Terms that are not defined herein shall have the meaning given to them in the General Terms, as updated from time to time. Where a term is defined both in the General Terms and in these Custodial Terms, for the purposes of these Custodial Terms only, the definition in these Custodial Terms shall prevail.

References in the Terms to the Lightbit Services and/or transactions shall include references to Custodial Services and the related services contemplated hereunder. These Custodial Terms shall be supplemental to and is to be read together with the General Terms. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between these Custodial Terms and the General Terms, these Custodial Terms shall prevail with respect to the services contemplated hereunder unless expressly stated otherwise.

This version of these Custodial Terms shall replace and supersede any previous Custodial Terms between us with respect to Custodial Services and any previous versions of these Custodial Terms that may have been accepted through, or otherwise made available on, the Platform. By entering into Custodial Services, you confirm your acceptance of these Custodial Terms and the General Terms.

1.1 Definitions.

"Custodial Wallet" means the digital wallet or storage system used by Lightbit to hold the Digital Asset on behalf of the User.

- 1.2 <u>Custody Services</u>. Lightbit may provide the following custody Services ("Custodial Services") to the User:
 - (a) secure storage of the Digital Asset in the Custodial Wallet;
 - (b) management and maintenance of the Custodial Wallet, including regular updates and security measures to ensure the safety and integrity of the Digital Asset;
 - (c) monitoring of the Digital Asset for any unauthorized access or suspicious activity; and
 - (d) facilitation of transactions, such as transfers, trades, and exchanges, as directed by the User.
- 1.3 <u>Access.</u> The User shall have access to the Digital Asset stored in the Custodial Wallet through a secure online portal or mobile application provided by Lightbit. The User shall be responsible for maintaining the security of their login credentials and shall immediately notify Lightbit of any unauthorized access to the portal or application.

1.4 <u>Fees.</u> No fees for Custodial Services are applicable at this moment. The fee may be introduced or adjusted by Lightbit at any time with ten (10) days' notice to the User.
